

ECB Approved Systems Test Match



The Test Match system is the 4th generation of the tried & tested combination of hard porous aggregate over a consolidated stone base. The ECB approved system has a combination of unique features designed to reduce maintenance & improve the longevity of the base. This sets it apart from other designs constructed on similar principles. It provides the greatest longevity of the aggregate base cricket systems.



Two layers of geo-textile are included to isolate the base aggregates & to prevent them from mixing in the crucial playing area. On top of the specialist playing aggregate AP10 Shockpad protects the surface from being damaged during use. This minimises maintenance & reduces the risk of having to remove the surface.

The pitch would be considered to medium paced but with a consistent rolling program, can get up to a very fast paced wicket. The system is designed to mimic the playing conditions in the middle, so in wetter weather it will play slower & lower.

During dry periods the surface will be faster.






The surface is suitable for both a match pitch or practice pitch. Non-ECB approved alternative surface is Super Verde Grass.

ECB Approved Systems Match Pitch



The Premier Pitch consists of a combination of factory formed underlays laid over a consolidated natural mineral base. With performance being controlled by fabricated components the influence of compaction & the effects of climate are limited. This enables the Premier Pitch to provide a very high level of consistency, making it excellent for match & practice by all age groups and abilities.



Pitches are easy paced to medium quick with bounce of half stump to stump high.

The Premier Pitch requires a comparatively low level of maintenance to keep the facility in top condition compared with other unbound base systems. With performance not being wholly dependent on base consolidation, pre-season rolling may be all that is required to consolidate any firmness that may have been lost during the winter due to water or frost.





Budget / Residential Surfacing & Systems



At Verde Sports we understand that both cricket clubs and private individuals cannot always justify the outlay of an ECB approved cricket system. The Cricket Range Surfaces & Underlays



Super Verde Wilton

8mm pile height with a woven structure that's uniformly permeable. Spike resistant allows for more accurate and safer practice & play. Durability allows for greater longevity compared to tufted alternatives

Super Verdeturf

15mm olive green tufted pile ideal for surrounds & additional run ups. A multi-use product that is utilised across several sports. Super Verdeturf is designed to be hard wearing and long lasting.

Super Verdegrass

12mm olive green tufted pile used as a non-ECB approved surface. Designed to take heavy traffic but maintain performance. Ideal for domestic use or budget option.

AP10 Shockad

A 44mm thick needle punch surface that is resin bonded. Utilised in both Test Match & Premier Systems. Designed to protect the aggregates below whilst not affecting performance.

Verdepitch

A green needle punch material with excellent wear. Great grip characteristics utilised for both indoor and outdoor use. The Verde Pitch is an alternative that doesn't require aggregates for use.

Premier Pad

Premier Pad – A custom in house pad utilising 4mm Foam bonded to fibre bonded carpet. The pad is used in our ECB approved "Premier" system and helps provide the characteristics of consistent bounce with increased spin/seam that are the hallmarks of the system.

Nurafilm

A geo-textile liner utilised in the sub-base that allows for moisture to pass through but prevents contamination of aggregates with each other and any surrounding materials.

Accessories Cages, Nets & Screens



Cages

High quality heavy-duty frames are supplied that consist of 3mm thick tubular steel with a 42mm diameter. Uprights are fixed using deep socket sets that are set in concrete. Elbows using grub screws pull the frame together and allow for it to be dismantled through winter if required.

The frame is made up of a series of bays that measure 3.60m x 3.66m and thus we can create whatever length the customer desires using these measurements. Additionally, we can provide extras like restricted use gates that allow clubs to limit use and thus maximise longevity.

Nets

Netting is available in four grades: 2mm knotted 2.3mm knotless 3mm knotless 3.6mm braided

The netting can be supplied with the roof & outer perimeter sewn together if required. Black or green netting is available for some grades to suit customer's requirement. Additionally, a lot of clubs now like to add Anti-Vermin skirts which can either be integral to the net or separate. This mesh screen stops animals from chewing through the net.

Batting Screens

Batting Screens are available and can be utilised in a few ways. They can be used as dividers between lanes to stop batsmen being distracted. Alternatively used behind batsmen to make it easier for bowlers to pick up balls returning towards them or fully wrapped around to incorporate all safety features.

At Verde Sports we like to make sure that whilst providing a great product it is also a safe product. That is why we fit all screens 0.10m above floor level to allow balls to drop through and stop people from lifting screens and being hit.

We also recommend that screens are no higher than 1.50m off the ground to allow coaches to see over the net in the event they are coaching.


Approved Installers & Distributors
